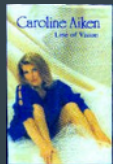
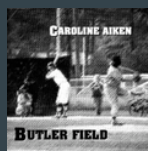
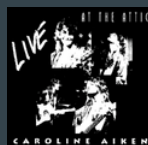
BIO
